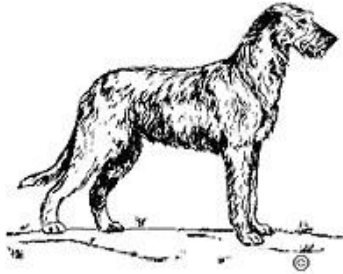

CLASSIFICATION

REGULAR CLASSES:

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches: Puppy, 6 Months & Under 9 Months; Puppy, 9 Months & Under 12 Months; 12-15 Months, 15-18 Months; Novice; Bred-by-Exhibitor; American-Bred; Open; Best of Breed Competition.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Single Dog Entries

VETERAN DOG CLASS – A Class for Dogs six (6) years or older.

VETERAN BITCH CLASS – A Class for Bitches six (6) years or older.

BEST HEAD and BEST GAIT: Upon the completion of Best of Breed competition there will be two non-regular AKC classes, **Best Gait** and **Best Head**. Entry fee for each of these two non-regular classes is \$10.00. Use the “**additional classes**” box on the entry form to enter.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries

As the judge’s decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and two or more of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record must be entered in Best of Breed Competition to be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

TEAM CLASS – Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner.

BREED PRIZES

Trophies marked (*) are offered through the Irish Wolfhound Association of New England, Inc. for competition at its shows only. For permanent possession, they are to be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog or at consecutive shows.

If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts or conditions beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show Will Be Open from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M. Sunday June 7, 2026.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Judges Are Not Required to Wait for Dogs. They will adhere as closely as practicable to the Judging Program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. IWANE and the Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility to provide service through a public address system or other means for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This event may be cancelled due to extremes in weather or other conditions considered being deleterious to the health and safety of dogs, exhibitors, judges and fanciers. No refund of entries will be made in such case.
